High Temperature / New, persistent Cough/Loss of or change in sense of taste or smell

Parent/Carers contacts school advising of suspected symptoms

School Text to be sent to all parents/carers of children within the 'Bubble' advising *'just to advise you— a parent/ carer has phoned the school today advising of suspected symptoms- a test has been advised'*,

Positive Test Result

Remain at home for 10 days from start of the symptoms

The school will contact the local Health Protection Team who will advise on further action

School Text to be sent to all parents/carers of children within the 'Bubble' advising them of the result

Negative test result

Symptoms

Stay at home until 48 hours after the temperature returns to normal. Siblings can return to school if they have not developed any symptoms

No symptoms

Pupil and any siblings may return to school

Return to School when symptoms have gone

Pupils can return to school after 10 days if their temperature has returned to within the normal range—if it is still above 37.8 c they should continue to isolate until 48 hours after the symptoms have stopped.
