

## Covid Catchup Funding 2020-21 – FRINTON

### INTRODUCTION

The government is providing funding to cover a one-off universal catch-up premium for the 2020 – 2021 academic year. It aims to support pupils to catch up for lost learning so schools can meet the curriculum expectations for the next academic year.

We have been tasked with the job of spending it in a way that is considered 'the most effective' way for our pupils and communities.

### OBJECTIVES FOR OUR SCHOOL

- The Covid catch-up funding will be used to provide additional educational support to improve the progress and to raise the standard of achievement for all pupils
- The funding will be used to narrow and close the gap between the achievement depending on pupil's home/school learning experience
- We will ensure that the additional funding reaches the pupils who need it most

### ACCOUNTABILITY

The Executive Head Teacher together with the Senior Leadership Team will regularly monitor, evaluate and review the strategies we have put into place for Covid catch-up funding and report to the Governing Body on its progress and impact. This will be part of the regular monitoring during half termly pupil premium meetings

### COVID CATCH-UP FUNDING

- The school receives £80 per pupil and will be received in three instalments. This equates to £16,640 for the year.
