It's been wonderful to see the children's enthusiasm to earn our new 'Wise Owl Reading Challenge' badges. In Key Stage 2, however, please note that we have given the children a target in terms of their 'reading-resilience' i.e. building up their stamina to read for longer, concentrated periods. We'll therefore only be giving them a maximum of two points per day when their Reading Record Book is signed by an adult at home – and any home reading session needs to be at least ten minutes long.
